Lea. 16/2014. -The following Act of the Legislature the State of Haryana received the Assent of the Governor 2014, Harvana on the 22nd March, and is hereby for general information :-

An Act to protect urban street vendors to earn livelihood, to regulate street vending activities and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Haryana in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- **1. Short title and extent.** (1) This Act may be called the Haryana Municipal Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.
- (2) It shall extend to all the municipalities in the State of Haryana.
- **2. Definitions.** (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "competent authority" means Commissioner in case of Municipal Corporation and Deputy Commissioner in case of Municipal Council/ Committee, as the case may be;
 - (b) "Government" means the Government of the State of Haryana in the Administrative Department;
 - (c) "municipality" means a municipality as defined in the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 (24 of 1973);
 - market" (d) "natural means а market where sellers and traditionally buyers have congregated for the sale and of products or services determined as such by the municipality on the recommendations of town vending committee;

- (e) "no vending zone" means an area which is not a vending zone;
- (f) "prescribed' means prescribed by rules made under this Act;
- (g) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to this Act;
- (h) "State Nodal Officer" means the Director, Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana;
- (i) "stationary vendors" mean street vendors who carry out vending activities on a regular basis at a specific location;
- (j) "street vendor" means a person engaged in vending articles, goods, wares, food items or merchandise of everyday use or offering services to the general public, side walk, footpath, pavement, in a street, lane, park or any other public place or private area, from a temporary built up structure or by moving from place to includes hawker, peddler and and all synonymous terms which may be local or region specific; words "street vending" with their grammatical and the variations and cognate expressions, shall be construed accordingly;
- (k) "town vending committee" means a committee constituted under section 3;
- (I) "vending zone" means an area or a place or a location designated such by the municipality on the as recommendations of the town vending committee, the specific use by street vendors for street vending includes footpath, side walk, pavement, embankment, portions of a street or any such place considered suitable for vending activities and providing services the to general public.
- 3. Town vending Committee. -(1)The competent authority shall constitute а town vendina committee municipality and may constitute more than one town vending committees for each ward, in each municipality.
- (2) The town vending committee shall consist of the following, namely:-

- (a) Municipal Commissioner in case of Corporation or Deputy Commissioner in case of Municipal Council/ Committee, as the case may be, who shall the Chairperson; and
- (b) such number of other members as maybe prescribed, by the Chairperson, representing be nominated local police, local police, association authority, traffic associations, street vendors, market non-governmental associations, organizations, community based organization, resident welfare and such other interests, associations banks as it deems proper;
- (c) ten percent members to be nominated to represent the non-governmental organizations and the community based organizations;
- (d) forty percent members representing the street vendors operating in that particular area:

Provided that one-third of the members shall be from amongst the women vendors:

Provided further that due representation shall be given to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, minorities and persons with disabilities from amongst the members representing the street vendor.

- Survey and registration of street vendors. -(1) The town vending committee shall within such а period be specified by the Government, such manner, as may all existing street vendors, survey of within a under its jurisdiction and subsequent survey shall carried out at least once in every five years.
- (2) The town vending committee shall ensure that all existing street vendors, identified in the survey are accommodated with vendina zones in accordance the plan for street vending and the holding capacity in the vending zones.
- (3) The town vendina committee shall ensure timely of the new street vendors and allotment of registration space to them for vending in accordance with the plan for street vending and holding capacity of vending zones.
- Issuance of certificate of vending. -(1)Every street vendor, identified under the survey carried out under subsection (1)of section 4, who has completed the age

eighteen years, shall be issued a certificate of vending by town committee subject to such terms vendina and conditions and within such period, as may be prescribed, including restrictions prescribed for street vending.

- Conditions of certificate 6. for issuance of vending. -(1) Every street vendor shall give an undertaking to the town committee prior the issue of a certificate of to vending under section 5 in such form and manner, as may be prescribed.
- (2) Where a street vendor to whom a certificate of vending is dies or suffers from any permanent or illness, one of his family members in the following order of his till the vend in place, validity the priority, may certificate of vending-
 - (a) spouse of the street vendor;
 - (b) dependent child of the street vendor:

Provided that where a dispute arises as to who is entitled to vend in the place of the vendor, the matter shall be decided by the State Nodal Officer.

- **7. Categories of certificate of vending and issuance of Identity card.** (1) The certificate of vending shall be issued to the followings, namely:-
 - (a) a stationary vendor; or
 - (b) a street vendor; or
 - (c) a mobile vendor; or
 - (d) any other category, as may be prescribed.

- of vending issued for (2) certificate the categories specified in sub-section (1) shall be in such form and issued such manner, as may be prescribed. It shall specify the vending zone where such vendor shall carry on his vendina and timinas the conditions activities, the days and shall restrictions subject to which he carryon such activities.
- (3) Every vendor who has been issued certificate of vending shall be issued identity card in such form and manner, as may be prescribed.
- Criteria for issuing certificate of vending. be followed by the town vending committee issuing certificate of vending to a street vendor shall be such, prescribed which may, apart from may be other things, for preference the Scheduled Castes, provide to Other Backward Tribes, Classes, women, persons with disabilities, minorities or such other categories.
- **9. Vending fee.** Every street vendor who has been issued certificate of vending shall pay such vending fee, as may be prescribed.
- **10.** Validity and renewal of certificate of vending. Every certificate of vending shall be valid for such period and shall be renewable for such period, in such manner and on payment of such fee, as may be prescribed.
- Cancellation or suspension of certificate of **vending.** - Where a street vendor who has been issued under this Act, commits breach certificate of vending of the conditions thereof or any other terms and conditions prescribed town vending committee is or where the such certificate of vending has been secured bv that through misrepresentation vendor or fraud, the committee vendina may, notwithstanding any other penalty imposed upon the street vendor under which may be Act, cancel the certificate of vending or suspend the same in such manner, as may be prescribed:

Provided that no such cancellation or suspension shall be made by the town vending committee unless an opportunity of hearing has been given to the street vendor.

Appeal. - (1) Any person who is aggrieved bv anv decision of the town vending committee with respect to issue of certificate of vending under section 5 or cancellation or suspension of certificate of vending under 11 section may prefer an appeal to the Divisional Commissioner in such

- form, within such period, and in such manner, as may be prescribed.
- (2) No appeal shall be disposed of by the Divisional Commissioner unless the appellant has been given an opportunity of hearing.
- **Right of street vendor.** (1) Every street vendor shall business riaht to carry on the of street vendina accordance conditions activities in with the terms and mentioned in the certificate of vending.
- contained sub-section Notwithstanding anything in (1),where any area or space, as the may be, been case has earmarked no-vending zone, street vendor shall as no carry out any vending activity in that zone.
- Right of street vendor for a site new or area **relocation.** - Every street vendor who possesses а certificate of vending shall in case of his relocation under section 16, be entitled, as far as possible, for new site or area, as the case activities may may be, for carrying out his vending as determined by the municipality in consultation with the town vending committee.
- **15. Duty of street vendors.** (1) Where a street vendor occupies space on a time sharing basis, he shall remove his goods and wares every day at the end of the time-sharing period allowed to him.
- (2) Every street vendor shall,-
 - (i) maintain cleanliness and public hygiene in the vending zones and the adjoining areas;
 - public (ii) maintain civic amenities and property the in condition and not vending in good damage zone or destruction destrov any damage to the or cause or same; and
 - (iii) pay such periodic maintenance charges for the civic amenities and facilities provided in the vending zones, as may be determined by the municipality.
- Relocation or eviction of street of goods. -(1)The municipality confiscation on vending recommendation of the town committee, declare zone or part of it to be a no vending zone for any public purpose and as far as possible relocate the street vendors vending in that area, in such manner, as may be prescribed.
- (2) The municipality shall evict such street vendor whose certificate of vending has been cancelled under section 11 or

- who does not have a certificate of vending and vends without such certificate, in such a manner, as may be prescribed.
- No street vendor shall be relocated or evicted by municipality from the place specified in the certificate he has been vendina unless given seven days notice the same, in such manner, as may be prescribed.
- (4) A street vendor shall be relocated or evicted by the municipality physically in such manner, as may be prescribed only after he had failed to vacate the place specified in the certificate of vending, after the expiry of the period specified in the notice.
- (5) Every street vendor who fails to relocate or vacate the place specified in certificate of vending, after the expiry of the period specified in the notice, shall be liable to pay, for every day of such default, a penalty which may extend up to two hundred and fifty rupees but shall not be more than the value of the goods seized.
- (6) Every street vendor shall vacate the premises immediately in case of any emergency on the notice of the District Magistrate or Sub-Divisional Magistrate for the period as specified in the notice.
- **17.** reclaiming of goods. - (1) If the Seizure and street vendor fails to vacate the place specified in the certificate lapse of specified in vending, after the period the given under sub-section (3) section municipality, of 16, the addition to evicting the street vendor under section may, if it deems necessary, seize the goods of such a street vendor in such manner, as may be prescribed:
- Provided that where any such seizure is carried out, a list of goods seized shall be prepared as may be prescribed and a copy thereof, duly signed by the person authorized to seize the goods, shall be issued to the street vendor.
- (2) The street vendor whose goods have been confiscated under sub-section (1) may, reclaim his goods in such manner and after paying such fee, as may be prescribed:
- that Provided in case of non-perishable goods, municipality shall release the goods within two working of the claim being made by the street vendor and in case of perishable goods the municipality shall release the goods on the same day of the claim being made by the street vendor.
- **18. Plan for street vending.** (1) Every municipality shall, in consultation with the town vending committee once in every five years prepare a plan to promote the vocation of street vendors covering matters contained in First Schedule.

- (2) The street vending plans prepared by the municipality shall submitted the town vending committee be to approval.
- **19. Meetings of town vending committee.** The town vending committee shall meet at least once in three months.
- 20. association with **Temporary** of persons town committee particular for purposes. -The town itself in committee may associate with such prescribed, and for such purposes, as may be any person whose assistance or advice it may desire, in carrying out any of the provisions of this Act.
- 21. Office space and other employees for town vending provide committee. -The municipality shall the town with appropriate committee office space and such employees as required to carry out the provision of this Act.
- **Publication** of vendor's street charter and (1) Every town vending committee shall publish vendor's charter specifying therein the street time of vending shall which the certificate be issued to a street vendor and the time within which such certificate of vending be renewed and other activities to be performed the time limit specified therein.
- Everv town vendina committee shall maintain up-to-date registered street and records of vendors street vendors containing whom certificate of vending has been issued of such street vendor, stall allotted to him, nature of business carried out by him, category of street vending and such other particulars which may be relevant to the street vendors.
- Prevention of by harassment police and other authorities. -Notwithstanding anything contained in State law for the time being in force, no street vendor, carries on the street vending activities in accordance with the certificate conditions of his vending and of shall he from exercising prevented such rights by person any or police or any other authority.
- 24. Penalty for contravention. Any street vendor who,-
 - (a) indulges in vending activities without a certificate of vending;
 - (b) contravenes the terms of certificate of vending; or
 - (c) other terms and conditions specified contravenes any street for purpose of regulating vending under the Act any rules or schemes made thereunder, shall

liable to a penalty for each such contravention which may extend upto two thousand rupees or as may be determined by the municipality.

- Provisions of this Act, not 25. to be construed ownership, rights etc. -Nothing conferring (1) shall be construed this Act as conferring upon of vendor temporary, permanent or perpetual riaht anv carrying out vending activities in the vending zones to him or in respect of any place on which he carries on such vending activity.
- Nothing contained in sub-section (1) shall apply to stationery vendor, if temporary leasehold or ownership a been conferred on him lease deed riaht has by а otherwise, in respect of a place at specific location where he carries on such vending activity.
- **26. Returns.** Every town vending committee shall furnish, from time to time, to the Government and the municipality such returns, as may be prescribed.
- **Promotional** measures. -The Government may, consultation with the town vending committee, municipality street vendor's associations unions, undertake or credit, making available promotional measures of insurance other welfare schemes of social security for the vendors.
- **28. Research, training and awareness.** The Government may, to the extent of availability of financial and other resources,-
 - (a) organise capacity building programmes to enable the street vendors to exercise the rights contemplated under this Act;
 - (b) education undertake research, and training advance knowledge programmes to and understanding the role of the informal sector in the economy, in general and the street vendors, in particular and to raise public through the awareness among the town vending committee.
- **29 Duties of competent authority.** The competent authority for the purposes of this Act shall perform the following duties, namely:-
 - (i) monitor the execution of schemes in the municipality;

- (ii) monitor the record of revenue generation and expenses by the town vending committee;
- (iii) resolve any discrepancy which arises within the town vending committee;
- (iv) call a joint meeting within every six months with the town vending committee.
- **30. Power to delegate.** The Government may, by or special order in writing, delegate such of its powers functions under this Act, as it may deem necessary, the municipality the town vending committee or or any other officer, subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified in that order.
- **31. Power to amend Schedule.** On the recommendations made by the town vending committee, if the Government is satisfied that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by notification, amend the Schedules.
- **32. Power to make rules.** (1) The Government shall have the power to make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
- (2) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing power, such rules/policy may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
 - (a) the number of other members of the town vending committee;
 - (b) the form, period and manner of filing appeal with the Divisional Commissioner;
 - (c) the term of, and the manner of constituting, the town vending committee;
 - (d) the manner and the purpose for which a person may be associated;
 - (e) the returns to be furnished;
 - (f) the manner of publishing summary of scheme;
 - (g) determination of monthly maintenance charges for the civic amenities and facilities in the vending zones;
 - (h) determination of penalty;
 - (i) any other matter which has to be or may be prescribed for carrying out the objective of this Act.

- **33. Power to make bye-laws.** Subject to the provisions of this Act or any rule or scheme made thereunder, the municipality may make bye-laws to provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
 - (a) the regulation and manner of vending in vending zones;
 - (b) the regulation of the collection of taxes and fee in the vending zones;
 - (c) the regulation of traffic in the vending zones;
 - (d) the regulation of the quality of products and services provided to the public in vending zones and maintenance of public health, hygiene and safety standards;
 - (e) the regulation of civic services in the vending zones; and
 - (f) the regulation of such other matters in the vending zones as may be necessary.
- **34. Scheme for street vendors.** (1) For the purposes of competent authority shall frame Act, the а within six months from the date of commencement of this after due consultations with the Act, town vendina specifying of the committee, all or any matters provided the Second Schedule.
- (2) A summary of the scheme under sub-section (1) shall be published by the municipality in at least two local Hindi newspapers in such manner, as may be prescribed.
- directions. -Power to issue The Government directions competent to issue such consonance with in section 32 of this Act for the proper enforcement the provisions issue till the rules are framed thereunder.
- **36. Power to remove difficulties.** If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the Government may, by order published in the Official Gazette, make such provisions, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as appear to it to be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty:

Provided that no order shall be made under this section after expiry of three years from the commencement of this Act.

37. Repeal and savings. - (1) The Haryana Municipal Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of

Street Vending) Ordinance, 2013 (Haryana Ordinance No.2 of 2014) is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.

Plan for Street vending

- (1) The Plan for street vending shall,-
 - (a) ensure that all existing street vendors identified in the survey are accommodated in the plan for street vending;
 - (b) ensure the right of commuters to move freely and use the roads without any impediment;
 - (c) ensure that the provision of space or area for street vending is reasonable and consistent with existing natural markets;
 - (d) take into account the civic facilities for appropriate use of identified spaces or areas as vending zones;
 - (e) promote convenient, efficient and cost effective distribution of goods and provision of services;
 - (f) such other matters as may be specified in the scheme to give effect to the plan for street vending.
- (2) The plan for street vending shall contain all of the following matters, namely:-
 - (a) determination of spatial planning norms for street vending;
 - (b) earmarking of space or area for vending zones;
 - (c) determination of vending zones as restriction-freevending zones, restricted vending zones and no-vending zones;
 - (d) making of spatial plans conducive and adequate for the prevalent number of street vendors in that city or town and also for the future growth, by adopting such norms as may be necessary;
 - (e) consequential changes needed in the existing master plan, development plan, zonal plan, layout plan and any

other plan for accommodating street vendors in the designated vending zones.

- Declaration of no-vending zone (3) shall be carried out bv the plan for street vending, subject to the following principles, namely:-
 - (a) any existing market, or a natural market as identified under the survey shall not be declared as a no-vending zone;
 - (b) declaration of no-vending zone shall be done in a manner which displaces the minimum percentage of street vendors;
 - (c) The area considered as overcrowded area by the Town Vending Committee may be declared as no-vending zone and the vendors in that area shall be relocated as far as possible to other locations;
 - (d) sanitary concerns may not be the basis for any area as a no-vending zone unless such concerns can solely attributed to street vendors and cannot be through resolved appropriate civic action by the local authority;

- (a) the manner of conducting survey;
- (b) the period within which certificate of vending shall be issued to the street vendors identified under the survey;
- (c) the terms and conditions subject to which certificate of vending may be issued to а street vendor includina to persons who wish carry to street vendina those on during the intervening period of two surveys;
- (d) the form and the manner in which the certificate of vending may be issued to a street vendor;
- (e) the form and manner of issuing identity cards to street vendors;

- (f) the criteria for issuing certificate of vending to street vendors;
- (g) the vending fee to be paid on the basis of category of street vending which may be different for different cities;
- (h) the manner of collecting, through banks, counters of counters Town municipality and of Vendina Committee, vending fee, maintenance charges and penalties for registration, use of parking space for mobile stalls and availing of civic services;
- (i) the period of validity of certificate of vending;
- period for which and the which manner in а certificate of vending may be fee renewed and the for such renewal;
- (k) the manner in which the certificate of vending may be suspended or cancelled;
- (I) the categories of street vendors other than stationery vendors and mobile vendors;
- (m) the other categories of persons for preference for issue of certificate of vending;
- (n) the public purpose for which a street vendor may be relocated and the manner of relocating street vendor;
- (o) the manner of evicting a street vendor;
- (p) the manner of giving notice for eviction of a street vendor;
- (q) the manner of evicting a street vendor physically on failure to evict;
- (r) the manner of seizure of goods by the municipality, including preparation and issue of list of goods seized;
- (s) the manner of reclaiming seized goods by the street vendor and the fee for the same;
- (t) the form and the manner for carrying out social audit of the activities of Town Vending Committee;

- (u) the conditions under which private places may be designated as restriction free-vending zones, restrictedvending zones and n-vending zones;
- (v) the terms and conditions for street vending including norms to be observed for up keeping public health and hygiene;
- (w) the designation of State Nodal Officer for co-ordination of all matters relating to street vending at the State Level;
- (x) the manner of maintenance of proper records and other documents by the town vending committee, municipality, and State Nodal Officer in respect of street vendors;
- (y) the manner of carrying out vending activities on timesharing basis;
- (z) the principles for determination of vending zones as restriction-free-vending zones, restricted-vending zones and no-vending zones;
- (za) the principles for determining holding capacity of vendina zones and the manner of undertaking comprehensive census and survey;
- (zb) principles of relocation subject to the following :-
 - (i) relocation should be avoided as far as possible, unless there is clear and urgent need for the land in question;
 - (ii) affected vendors or their representatives shall be involved in planning and implementation of the rehabilitation project;
 - livelihood opportunities created by new development infrastructure projects shall accommodate the displaced vendors so that they can make use of the livelihood opportunities created bν the new infrastructure;
 - (iv) loss of assets shall be avoided and in case of any loss, it shall be compensated;
 - (v) any transfer of title or other interest in land rights of street not affect the vendors on such land, and relocation consequent upon such transfer any а

- shall be done in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
- (vi) State machinery shall take comprehensive measures to check and control the practice of forced evictions;
- (vii) natural where street markets vendors have conducted business for over fifty years shall be heritage markets, and the declared as street vendors in such markets shall not be relocated.
- (zc) any other matter which may be included in the scheme for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
